Christmas Fair Arrangements

The fair starts at 3pm and so children are able to leave school early with an adult if they are going to visit the fair.

The school doors will open at 3pm. Parents will be able to come into school and collect their children from the classrooms. All children must be signed out by an adult - either the adult collecting the child or the teacher.

All Y5 and 6 children will be in the Y6 classroom on the main corridor.

All Y3 and 4 children will be in the Y4 classroom on the main corridor.

All Year 2 children will be in Oak Class.

All Year 1 children will be in Elm Class on the main corridor.

All Reception and Teddy's children will be in Reception (Ash Class) on the infant corridor.

If your child is being picked up by someone else, please make sure that you have informed the class teacher who that person is by 9am on the morning of the fair. We will not be able to pass telephone messages on during the day about different pick up arrangements because it will be an incredibly busy day.

We will not let a child go with another parent unless we have permission in writing via email. This includes adults who are related to the children.

Stay and Play Club will be located on the main corridor. During the fair, please do not enter this corridor unless you are collecting your child from Stay and Play.

These measures have been put in place to safeguard the children and we would be grateful if parents could please assist us in this matter. Please do share this information with other family members if they are involved in collecting children tomorrow.

A quick reminder that the fine on Friday for wearing non uniform in a Christmas style is chocolate/selection box for children in nursery, reception, Year 1 and Year 2 and a bottle for children in Year 3, 4, 5 and 6.

The cost of the meal is £2.30 and we will put the payment on Parent Pay the week after.

Christmas Theatre Trips

Thank you to everyone who has already paid for the Christmas Theatre trips. Payments can be made on Parent Pay.

Teddy's Nursery, Reception class, year 1 and year 2 will be going to the Lowry Theatre, Salford on Thursday 19th December to watch Gruffalo's Child. The coach will depart from school at 9.30am and arrive at the Lowry in time for an 11.00am start. The children will be back at school by 1.00pm and packed lunches will be provided. The cost for this trip is £14.20.
