We would also like every child who has individual music lessons to take part as it is a great opportunity to perform to a live audience.

Driving and Parking around school

The number of reports we are receiving of dangerous driving around our school is ever increasing. The safety of all our children is very important to us. Please can we remind all of our school community to drive with care? We would be very grateful if this information could be shared with all family members who pick up and drop off from school. Here are a few reminders:

Do

- Use the school car park
- Park in a designated parking space
- Walk to school if possible
- Park at the Marriott if the school car park is full

Do not

- Drive down Church Lane beyond the turning circle at any time (including picking up and dropping off at Stay and Play). Beyond this point it is school and church property and is not a public road.
- Use the reserved parking bays by the church – these are for clergy only.
- Park on Garstang Road.
- Park on the pavement on Garstang Road.
- Park in a disabled bay unless you have a blue badge or are otherwise entitled.
- Park on the corner of Church Lane.
- Drive the wrong way round the car park. Clockwise only please.
- Park in the turning circle or on double yellow lines in the school car park.

After half term we will be setting up an Incident Book to record any incidents taking place.



Increase in fees – school meals and Stay and Play

The governing body have decided to increase fees for school meals and Stay and Play. We have not increased fees for a few years and we need to keep up with inflation to enable us to cover costs. The fee increase will be by 2% - approximately 10 pence - and will start from September.
